Projects

SOCC (statement of community consultation) being prepared for Spring 2026. Cllr Cole requested that the CLCLG have sight of this before it goes public. Cornwall Council have reviewed it and are content with the approach CL are taking. A booklet will be published in early January, the idea is to deliver it to all households (they have 10,000 addresses) in areas where CL will be working. Official notification of the publication of the SOCC will be in St Austell Voice, social media etc.

Land notices

These have gone up on parcels of land where the ownership or who has interest in the land is unclear as some pieces of land are not registered.

Community

Meeting theme – Footpaths
