Clerk's Report for October 25

Playing Field:

- Grass seed has been spread across the recently levelled ground at Penny Darn.
- There have been several issues with people obtaining access to Penny Darn by bending back the fence panels these have now been fixed back in place securely.
- There have been several incidents of attempts to brake fencing around the perimeter of the playing field.
- One of the trees planted at the entrance of the playing field has been broken.
- The platforms to be replaced on the multi climb unit have been delivered.
- A collection of scrap metal has been arranged to clear the playing field shed of broken pushbikes.
- The new skatepark sign has been damaged holes have been put through it.

Cemetery:

- 1 new memorial permits have been issued.
- 2 new Exclusive Rights of Burial have been issued.
- A member of the public has highlighted that there is no disabled access to the garden of rest.
- Flanders Field has been planted ready for Remembrance Day.
- Staff have advised that bins are being overloaded by visitors cleaning grave spaces and throwing lumps of turf into the bins.

General:

- The first mobile speed sign has been erected in Hall Road whilst doing this it was highlighted that additional solar brackets being erected on each pole would make moving the units easier.
- The new bench base at Freda's triangle has had graffiti sprayed on it.
- The advanced warning signs have been put out for the Remembrance Day Parade.
