

Working Party report from the 18th October 2023
Those Present Cllr Clarke, Cllr Harwood, Cllr Griffin.

Items of concern reported: -

- 1 - Weeds along the wall on the entrance from the road along to the shed.
- 2 – CCTV signs – nothing on the entrance gates. Only one CCTV sign still in place on the lower fence.
- 3 – Benches and bins in the young children’s playing area need a good wash off
- 4 – A leaf blower would be an advantageous to the chaps – leaves could be blow into one side then collected and disposed of.
- 5 – There was poo of some sort in the dish roundabout – we told Brian about it and he cleaned it up (in fairness to Brian he hadn’t gone into that area before we got there).
- 6 – the rubber handle is split on the blue springy
- 7 – the spy glasses have rust showing through the eye pieces
- 8 – brambles coming through the fencing in the young children’s area and in several places around the field.
- 9 – Young children’s fencing has a dog fouling sign which has been bent and now there are sharp edges pointing out to the pathway.
- 10 – Several items on the outside gym have rust showing through plus bearing suspect?
- 11 – Anti climb paint signs are missing throughout the playing field – only few left
- 12 – Grass in lower section from skatepark down still lying – some being taken into skate park by youngsters’ feet and bikes etc
- 13 – around perimeter behind fencing there is a lot of vegetation which would benefit from being strimmed or sprayed.
- 14 – Vegetation growing around the fencing to the CCTV unit – looks like a green curtain.
- 15 – Dog fouling sign on post near the skatepark – cable ties sticking out approximately 12 inches from the sign.
- 16 – both entrance gates to the smaller children’s play area need attention – sticking out could hurt eyes or faces. Possibly need to re-visit self-closures?
