Possible entertainment suggested:-

2nd June – Lighting Beacon

possible torch light procession from the school to the Church for lighting of the beacon

Action - KS to speak to local metal workers regarding construction of the fire basket for the beacon

Action - NE to inspect the poles in the playing field to ascertain if they are suitable to mount the Beacon on – alternatively speak to DSW to see if they have suitable pole

School to be approached to ask if the children would wish to take part – **Action to** ask **TE** if she would speak to the school

Action - JC to contact Fire Brigade to ask if they could accompany the parade to the Church

JC has spoken to Lewis – Tri Service officer he will contact the Chief Fire Officer to see if this is possible

Action - JC to contact the CERC to ask for support in some form from them. JC has emailed the CERC and they have offered to provide the crowd barriers for the lighting of the Beacon – just need to know how many and where and when to deliver them.

Action - JC to contact St Dennis band and ask if they would accompany the torch light parade

JC has contacted the Band and they are very happy to attend – f.o.c.

Action - Need to contact Mr D Strigley as he has horses in the field next to the Church car park

Suggestion – run a competition where the winner lights the beacon **Need** – torches for the parade – what sort, what cost and where from?? **Possible** organise for a Soup/Tea/Coffee wagon for the event

Friday 3rd June – Fete in the Playing field

Contact St Dennis Band as they have several "fete type" games **Action – JC to contact the Band**

JC has spoken to the Band and they have several games available i.e. skittles, bash the rat etc which they would be happy to lend f.o.c. for the day

Action - Need to confirm with the Parish Council that they are happy to permit this activity in the playing field and hopefully cover the event with their insurance?

Possible suggestions:-Hire Bouncy Castle Snack wagon? Need 1st aid cover

Ask Fire brigade to park fire engine on the playing field so that the youngsters can have a good look at it

Action – JC to speak to Tri Service officer

JC has spoken to Tri Service officer and he is going to speak to Chief Fire officer and get back to her

Saturday 4th June – Street Party at the Working Men's car park

Suggestions:-Cream teas Bunting Imery's Male Voice Choir Action - SK & W.I. to investigate

JC has spoken to the St Dennis Band and they will be available to play in the afternoon

Need – crockery, cutlery, tables, chairs etc

Other suggestions:-

Anniversary mugs for sale or f.o.c.? (Catalogue has been forwarded to those present)

Queen scarecrow competition around village

Coins for all children in parish
